

## Michael Arthur Klotz Memorial "Pay It Forward" Blood Drive

Michael Arthur ("Mike") Klotz was a Bronx-born Science Fiction & Fantasy Fan, a polymath, an alumnus of the Animal Room at Bronx Science, and one of the original Dom's Kids.



His bumpy ride through the annals of medicine started at age 6 with a diagnosis of bilateral pyelonephritis that ultimately led to kidney failure at 21, two failed transplants, near-fatal peritonitis at 31 and finally, terminal liver and heart failure at 34. Through it all he fought incessantly, with his pet dog Ephos by his side. There was very little Michael didn't know something about. At his dialysis clinic, he was known as the "Bookman" who refused to wear pajamas for treatment. His life was about always searching for answers!

He even entered medical school and completed a Masters degree in Bio-Informatics when doctors could not find his answers quickly enough. His transplant surgeries and other treatments required considerable quantities of donated blood as well as other organs and tissues.

The need for blood is still critical throughout the tri-state area.
